URGENT PRAYER NEEDED! Think of the world’s 6 billion people and how many die each year without receiving Christ. (In India, 800 million are still submerged in Hinduism; in China alone, 2 million die every month without Christ.) Pour out your heart to God for them.

And don’t forget the Jews and all the ministries to Jews around the world. Consider God’s heart for the Jewish people throughout the centuries, though most have spurned His Son, His best love gift to them. He expressed His love so well in Hosea 11:8, NLT: “O how can I give up, Israel? How can I let You go? How can I destroy you...? My heart is torn within me, and my compassion overflows.” Your prayers can hasten the day when God will restore the nation of Israel to Himself and to His great purposes for them.

J. O. Fraser wrote: “Many of us cannot reach the mission fields on our feet, but we can reach them on our knees. Solid, lasting missionary work is accomplished by prayer, whether offered in China, India, or the United States.”
