#### **PRAYER PROMPTS**

- Pray for the application of this week’s Touch Power—God’s amazing power and plan—to situations you are facing. Be prepared to share that assurance with someone who needs to hear it this week, and offer to pray for their particular situation.
- Apply this week’s thoughts in your prayers for our “Stepping Out in Faith...for the Sake of the Gospel” initiative. - Prayerfully reflect on the lessons from Sunday’s worship service, the music, Scripture, and Pastor Dave’s message “I’m Forgiven . . . Because He was Forsaken”\* from Matthew 27.
- Pray for the ministry of Vacation Bible School, directed this year by Bridgette Ecklund. Pray specifically for enough volunteers and for God’s blessing on Bridgette as she organizes this year’s program. Begin to pray also for the children who will come and for their families as well.
- Pray that more individuals will visit Evangel (several have come recently because they saw our sign) and pray that more will decide to return after their initial visit. Be ready to extend an invitation yourself as we seek the Lord’s blessing to be kingdom builders!
