Reflection

God has given us a mandate to live in such a way that the next generation will know that the Lord is God and that he is worthy of our committing our lives to him. Then an entire generation of godly people will rise up and be blessed. This psalm describes some of the keys to blessing the next generations with the truth. Those who pass on the spiritual baton to the next generation will be people who fear and worship the Lord, who delight in doing his will, and who walk in such an intimate relationship with him that they don't even fear bad times because they are so confident of God's care for them. These godly men and women will not only run the race themselves and live a life of joy and purpose as they delight in doing what God commands, but they will also bless those of the next generation by passing their spiritual legacy to them. What is the best way for you to influence those who will come after you? Fear the Lord today, take delight in obeying him, and trust that he will care for you.

PRAYER PROMPTS

- Do you have an "impact list"—people for whom you are praying? Pray this week that the Lord will enrich your relationship with one or more of these people, and reflect on your role to "pass the baton" of faith.
- Continue to pray for our "Stepping Out in Faith" initiative: for the identification of a church planter, for unity and commitment as we seek to bring success to this evangelistic effort by growing ourselves. Take seriously Bill France's challenge to pray that God will lead 25 adults and 50 children to Evangel by year's end—a seemingly impossible task. It has already started.
- Praise God for the affirmation received last Wednesday in the meeting between Mark Albrecht of Converge
 MidAmerica and several from Evangel. There was a positive sense that we are on a God-ordained path. Pray that a
 planter may emerge from a number that Mark suggested could be a good fit; and for Mark's meetings in the next
 two weeks at Trinity and Moody to seek out and encourage those who would make effective church planters.
- Prayerfully reflect on the lessons from Sunday's worship service, the music, Scripture, and Pastor Dave's message on "The Church: Beginning and Becoming" as he continues with the part 13 of this series, this week looking at the letter to the church at Sardis in Revelation 3.* Reflect on the letter that Jesus would write to the church in America today—as Pastor Dave suggested, write a letter to Evangel before our next "Conversation with Council" on October 6 (note the delay of one week because of a video on the seven churches on September 29).
