When a Friend Feels Like Retreating

The current series of Touch Points is taken from “Time Out in Tough Times,” from the editors of Guideposts (MIF Books, 2009). The reflections come from a variety of writers.

READ: For you, brethren, have been called to liberty; only do not use liberty as an opportunity for the flesh, but through love serve one another.

Galatians 5:11

REFLECT: Colorado drivers quickly learn the cardinal rule of winter driving: When sliding on ice, always steer into the direction of the skid. My instinctive reaction tells me to turn the wheel in the other direction. But I have to admit from experience that steering into the slide works.

I thought about this opposite solution the other day when I was feeling sad and discouraged. My instinctive reaction was to retreat within the protective solitude of my home. That's what I was doing when a friend phoned and asked me to fill in for her at the volunteer desk at the high school. It was the exact opposite of what I felt like doing, but for some reason I said, "Okay."

Several hours later I was driving home in a totally turned around mood. Doing something for someone else was the very opposite of what I felt like doing, but it steered me out of my bad mood.
