When a Friend is Physically Handicapped

The current series of Touch Points is taken from "Time Out in Tough Times," from the editors of Guideposts (MIF Books, 2009). The reflections come from a variety of writers. This week we continue the focus on friends. That focus will change over time as we work our way through selections from the book.

READ: We also who have the first fruits of the Spirit, even we ourselves groan within ourselves, eagerly waiting for the adoption, the redemption of our body.

Romans 8:23

REFLECT: Our newspaper ran a picture of what a six-year-old boy's idea of heaven was like. The child suffered a handicap that kept him indoors, where he sat at the window and watched children playing. He longed to join them.

In childish lines, the picture showed a park crammed with swings, slides and merry-gorounds. A stick figure that represented the child himself played on everything in the park.

It seems to me that the little boy had grasped the great truth Paul talked about in Romans 8:23 (TLB): "We groan to be released from pain and suffering. We . . . wait anxiously for that day when God will give us our full rights as his children, including the new bodies he has promised us—bodies that will never be sick again and will never die."

Someday all Christians will be released from frustrations and limitations that hold us down in this life!
