## When You're Learning to Trust God

The current series of Touch Points is taken from "Time Out in Tough Times," from the editors of Guide-posts (MIF Books, 2009). The reflections come from a variety of writers.

READ: We have such trust through Christ toward God. 2 Corinthians 3:4

**REFLECT:** Our two-year-old granddaughter Jamie was visiting. She scurried ahead of me one evening as we made our way down the stairs to the kitchen for a cookie. She was halfway down the stairs before she realized how dark it was.

Just as I rounded the corner behind her, I saw her sturdy little shape. She stood perfectly still, looking ahead, one hand on the banister and the other hand outstretched over her head, waiting for mine.

I paused for a moment and looked at her. She waited so patiently, so calmly. She didn't turn around to see if I was coming, or even call out. She simply stood there, still and quiet, one small hand lifted up.
